3 joining KCPL, I worked as an attorney for a private law firm in Springfield, Missouri.  
4 Prior to my work in Springfield, I was employed as an attorney by the State of  
5 Missouri. I have been licensed as an attorney in Missouri since May of 1975. I have  
6 held a variety of positions at KCPL including Manager of Labor Relations, Director  
7 of Employee Relations, Senior Attorney, Director of Environmental Services and my  
8 current position of Director of Resource Protection.

9 **Q: Have you previously testified in a proceeding at the Kansas Corporation  
10 Commission (“KCC”) or before any other utility regulatory agency?**

11 A: I have not testified before the KCC, but I have testified before the Missouri Public  
12 Service Commission.

13 **Q: What is the purpose of your testimony?**

14 A: The purpose of my testimony is to discuss KCPL’s security enhancement projects and  
15 their relation to the cost recovery mechanisms of the Kansas Energy Security Act.
