MARC Solid Waste Management District Regional HHW Collection Program

The MARC Solid Waste Management District encompasses Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte and Ray counties in Missouri. The Regional HHW Collection Program is designed to provide convenient access to proper HHW disposal for all district residents. Residents of participating communities may take HHW products to the **permanent collection facilities** in Kansas City, Missouri and Lee's Summit at no charge. Proof of residency is required. *There is a disposal charge per vehicle for residents of non-participating members.*

In addition, residents of participating communities may drop off HHW products at any of the **mobile collections** to be held throughout the year. To find out exact locations for upcoming mobile collections, please call 816-701-8226.

CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MO 4707 DERAMUS just south of the Chouteau Bridge in the east river bottoms
816/784-2080 Hours: Thursday, Friday, and Saturday 9 a.m.- 4 p.m. **Appointment required.**

CITY OF LEE'S SUMMIT, MO 2101 SE HAMBLIN ROAD at the Lee's Summit Resource Recovery Park
816/969-1805 Hours: 7 a.m. - 12 noon. Open on the first Saturday of the month and one Wednesday, 2 pm – 6:30 pm (paint only on Wednesdays), April thru November: April 7, 18; May 5, 16; June 2, 20; July 7, 15; August 4, 15; September 8, 19; October 6, 17; November 3. **Appointment required.** 100 lb. limit per visit.

The facilities accept: automotive fluids, batteries, fuels, household cleaners, lawn & garden products, pesticides, paint and related products.

The facilities do not accept: explosives, yard waste, medical waste, commercial waste, pressurized gas cylinders, asbestos, tires, appliances.

Who can bring waste: No charge for residents of Regional HHW Collection Program Participants (see above). You must bring an ID with proof of residency. There is a disposal charge per vehicle for residents of non-participating communities.

WYANDOTTE COUNTY, 2443 S. 88th St.

This facility accepts: batteries, fertilizers, flammables, hazardous cleaners, hazardous liquids, herbicides, paints, pesticides, recyclables, solvents, tires, used oil.

This facility does not accept: explosives, yard waste, medical waste, commercial waste, pressurized gas cylinders, and asbestos.

Who can bring waste: Wyandotte County Residents only. You must bring an ID with proof of residency.

Hours: 3rd Saturday of the month (April through October), 8:30am-1pm.

CITY OF OLATHE, KS, 1385 Robinson

This facility accepts: batteries, fertilizers, flammables, hazardous cleaners, hazardous liquids, herbicides, paints, pesticides, used oil, and solvents.

This facility does not accept: explosives, yard waste, medical waste, commercial waste, pressurized gas cylinders, asbestos, tires.

Who can bring waste: Olathe Residents only. You must bring a water bill and ID with proof of residency.

Hours: 2nd Saturday of the month 8am-12noon.

JOHNSON COUNTY, Mission, KS. APPOINTMENT REQUIRED

This facility accepts: batteries, fertilizers, flammables, hazardous cleaners, hazardous liquids, herbicides, paints, pesticides, used oil, and solvents.

This facility does not accept: explosives, yard waste, medical waste, commercial waste, pressurized gas cylinders, and asbestos.

Who can bring waste: Johnson County Residents only. You must bring an ID with proof of residency.

Hours: Call for an appointment.

This facility accepts: automotive products, antifreeze, batteries, fertilizers, flammables, herbicides, household cleaning products, paints, pesticides, photographic chemicals, pool chemicals, solvents, thinners, used oil.

This facility does not accept: explosives, yard waste, medical waste, commercial waste, pressurized gas cylinders, and asbestos.

Who can bring waste: Leavenworth County Residents only. You must bring an ID with proof of residency.

Hours: Monday through Saturday, 7:30 am-5pm.
