How It Works

1. An assessment of the home's energy use is done by either a consultant or contractor chosen by the customer. The Home Energy Assessment is an energy evaluation of the home that includes observation of lighting and appliances as well as performance testing of the ventilation and mechanical systems, building tightness, and insulation levels that will result in a scope of work outlining recommended energy efficiency improvements.
2. All Home Energy Assessments must be performed by a certified Home Performance with ENERGY STAR contractor or consultant to qualify for a rebate.
3. To qualify for the Home Energy Assessment rebate, the customer must implement at least one recommended energy-efficiency improvement approved by KCP&L. "Qualifying" improvements *exclude* gas-only equipment (e.g. gas tankless water heater) and improvements associated with other KCP&L programs. Example: If you upgrade your heating and cooling equipment and receive a Cool Homes rebate, you are *not* eligible to receive the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR rebate for that same improvement. You can still qualify for the rebate by implementing a second improvement.
4. The selected improvements must be installed by a contractor to qualify for the rebate. *Some exceptions do apply.* The customer will work with the contractor to complete measures identified in assessment.
5. The customer may qualify for a rebate amount up to \$600. The actual amount of the rebate will be based on the cost of the Home Energy Assessment and the cost of the implementation of recommended energy-efficiency improvements that are approved by KCP&L. KCP&L reserves the right to award the rebate in the form of a bill credit.

Qualifying Equipment for Rebates

Table 1 shows the equipment that is considered eligible for a rebate through this program. Energy-efficiency improvements may include but are not limited to measures that are applied to the home to eliminate air leaks, add insulation, seal ductwork and improve electric heating and cooling systems.

- Program rebates are limited to one rebate per assessment.
